

# GRADUATE ADMISSIONS CHECKLIST

## GET PREPARED

- Take a graduate tour of campus. [gograd.unt.edu/tours](http://gograd.unt.edu/tours)
- Connect with a graduate advisor or key faculty in your area of interest to discuss graduate school options and admission requirements.\* [gograd.unt.edu/advising](http://gograd.unt.edu/advising)
- Prepare your application materials at least two months prior to the departmental application date. International applicants may need additional time to process documents.

\*UNT reviews graduate program applications holistically. We consider all parts of the application and supporting documentation to determine admission. Contact your department directly for specific requirements.

## TWO-PART APPLICATION PROCESS

The UNT graduate application is a concurrent two-part process. All graduate applicants must complete the Toulouse Graduate School admission requirements, but most programs have additional requirements.

- 1 Apply to the Toulouse Graduate School at [www.applytexas.org](http://www.applytexas.org) and pay the application fee. Send transcripts from all colleges attended to the graduate school office.
- 2 Apply to the department and submit all supporting application materials.

## GRADUATE SCHOOL APPLICATION PRIORITY DATES

Complete the graduate school application by the following dates. Check with your departmental advisor for specific deadlines and details.\*\*

SEMESTER	GENERAL	INTERNATIONAL
Fall	June 15	April 1
Spring	Oct. 15	Oct. 15
Summer	April 15	Jan. 1

\*\* Applying by departmental priority dates affords you the most options for enrollment and financial support. Many programs will still consider your application after these dates.

## THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND

### TEST SCORES

- Check with your department to determine test score requirements. If admissions exams are required, submit your test scores to the department through the testing agency.

### MONEY

- Apply for scholarships, assistantships and fellowships.
- Check with your department for assistantship and fellowship applications.
- Apply for financial aid at [fafsa.gov](http://fafsa.gov). Priority date: **Jan. 15**

- General academic scholarship priority date: **March 1**

- Priority date for other awards: **Varies by program**

### APPLICATION STATUS

- Check the status of your admission application through your [my.unt.edu](http://my.unt.edu) portal.

## AFTER YOU'RE ADMITTED

- Review the UNT Graduate Student Success Manual linked in your admission letter.
- Attend a graduate orientation session in person or online. [orientation.unt.edu/graduate](http://orientation.unt.edu/graduate)
- International students are required to attend international orientation.
- Many departments have their own additional orientation.
- Meet with your advisor to determine course options.
- Register for classes. [unt.edu/register](http://unt.edu/register)
