





#### TWO-PART APPLICATION PROCESS

The UNT graduate application is a **concurrent two-part process.** All applicants must complete the Toulouse Graduate School admission requirements, but most programs have additional requirements.

1 Apply with our general university application at ApplyTexas.org and pay the \$75 application fee. Send official transcripts from all colleges attended to UNT admissions.

2 Apply to your department and submit all supporting application materials.
